### DIRECTIONS TO LAPORTE HIGH SCHOOL, 602 F Street, LaPorte, IN 46350

Option 1 from Chicago: From the Skyway and Indiana Toll Road (I-80/90) take the Michigan City exit #39 and turn south (right) on US 421. Then take IN 2 east (left) and follow into LaPorte. Once you enter LaPorte at the third stoplight turn east (right) on 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Follow this one block to LPHS.

Option 2 from Chicago: From the Tri-State I-294 or I-80/94 take I-94 east to the US 20/35 LaPorte exit and follow the US 35 south signs into downtown LaPorte. After crossing the overpass downtown by the courthouse turn right at the stoplight on Lincolnway/IN 2 west. Follow IN 2 signs as after a turn this becomes "J" St. Turn left on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and follow one block to LPHS.

From Michigan: From I-94 take the New Buffalo/LaPorte exit #1 for MI 239 and go south. Follow this into Indiana where it will become IN 39 and take you into downtown LaPorte. After crossing the overpass downtown by the courthouse turn right at the stoplight on Lincolnway/IN 2 west. Follow IN 2 signs as after a turn this becomes "J" St. Turn left on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and follow one block to LPHS.

From the south: Follow US 35 north into downtown LaPorte. In downtown at the courthouse turn left on Lincolnway/IN 2 west. Follow IN 2 signs as after a turn this becomes "J" St. Turn left on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and follow one block to LPHS.

From the east: Follow IN 2/Lincolnway west through downtown LaPorte. After a turn past downtown this will become "J" Street. Turn left on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and follow one block to LPHS.

## UNIT INFORMATION

### WELCOME & EXPECTATIONS

LaPorte High School is proud to again host the MWCGC Championship! We are very proud of our facility and ask that everyone do their part in order for us all to experience a great weekend like we have come to expect of our MWCGC Championship. Please follow all signs, procedures, and proper contest etiquette in order that we may all have an enjoyable weekend!

### SPECTATOR ENTRANCE

All spectators should park in the I Street (west side) parking lot and enter at the main entrance.

### UNIT CHECK-IN

Unit check-in will be on the F Street (east) side of the building via the student parking lot at door 23, the Natatorium entrance. Buses should park in the student parking lot on F Street.

### PROPS

Props should be unloaded on the I Street (west) side of the building at door 29. Enter the Receiving Parking Lot next to the Cafeteria loading dock. This area is located south of the main I Street parking lot on I Street. Prop loading after performances will be via the F Street (east side) student parking lot at door 22. Units housed at LPHS may store their props in hallways near their housing area and take them directly to the holding area for performance. **HOWEVER**, please be respectful of the flow of the contest. Do not block the way of units who have finished their performances and are trying to refold floors and exit.

### HOMEROOM AREA

The cafeteria will serve as a homeroom area for all units not housed at LPHS. Please be respectful to others and take the least amount of space you need!

### WARM-UP

There will be a one-way routing in and out of warm-up. **Units will enter warm-up through the cafeteria, NOT through the hallway. The hallway is for exit only. This also applies to units housed at LPHS.** Our fieldhouse will feature 2 full basketball court size areas to accommodate two units warming up side by side.

### FLOOR REFOLDING

Immediately following performance units may refold floors in the small gym. Please plan to immediately refold your floor following performance to avoid congestion.

The circuit meeting will be held following the Saturday prelims at 3:30 PM in the Auditorium.
